## 1 Kings 17:3


Get thee hence, and turn thee eastward, and hide thyself by the brook Cherith, that is before Jordan.



## 1 Kings 17:8-9

And the word of the LORD came unto Elijah saying, Arise, get thee to Zarephath, behold,

**I have commanded a widow woman there to sustain thee**

Here God commands a widow woman to provide for Elijah



## 1 Kings 17:10-11

The widow woman was there gathering of sticks: and he called to her, and said, Fetch me, I

**Fetch me, I pray thee, a little water in a vessel,**

that I may drink. And as she was going to fetch it, he called to her, and said, Bring me, I pray

**thee, a morsel of bread in thine hand.**

## 1 Kings 17:12

And she said, As the LORD thy God liveth, I have not a cake, but an handful of meal in a barrel, and a little oil in a cruse: and, behold, **I am gathering two sticks, that I may go in and dress it for me and my son, that that we may eat it, and die**

## 1 Kings 17:15-16

And **she went and did according to the saying of Elijah** and she, and he, and her house, did eat many days. **And the barrel of meal wasted not, neither did the cruse of oil fail, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake by Elijah**

## 2 Kings 4:42

And there came a man from Baal-shalisha, and brought the man of God bread of the first fruits, twenty loaves of barley, and full ears of corn in the husk thereof.

## 2 Kings 4:42-43

And Elisha said, Give unto the people, that they may eat. And his servitor said, What, should I set this before an hundred men?

## 2 Kings 4:43

Elisha said again, Give the people, that they may eat: for thus saith the LORD, **They shall eat, and shall leave thereof**

**So he set it before them, and they did eat, and had left** according to the word of the LORD.

## 2 Kings 4:38

## The Famine of the CURSE (How it concluded)

2 Kings 7

Then Elisha said, Hear ye the word of the LORD; Thus saith the LORD, To morrow about this time shall a measure of fine flour be sold for a shekel, and two measures of barley for a shekel, in the gate of Samaria.

2 Kings 7:2

Then the lord on whose hand the king leaned answered the man of God, and said, Behold, if the LORD would make windows in heaven, might this thing be? And he said, Behold, **thou shalt see it with thine eyes, but shalt not eat thereof**

2 Kings 7

the Lord had made the host of the Syrians to hear a noise of chariots, and a noise of horses, even the noise of a great host: and they arose and fled in the twilight, and left their tents

2 Kings 7

These lepers came to the camp and said come that we may go and tell the king's household. So they came and called unto the porter of the city: and they told them and they told it to the king's house within

And the king appointed the lord on whose hand he leaned to have the charge of the gate

And the people trode upon him in the gate, and he died, as the man of God had said.
