Luke 12:47

And that servant, **which knew his lord's will** and prepared not himself, neither did according to his will, shall be beaten with many stripes.

**Greater
punishment**

Luke 12:48

But **he that knew not** and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes.

**Lesser
punishment**

These Know the LORD'S will

Hebrews 6.4-5

For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made **partakers** **of the Holy Ghost**,

Hebrews 6.4-6

And have tasted the good Word of God, and the Powers of the age to come, If they shall fall away, **to renew them again unto repentance** seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame

The ENTIRETY of the Born Again Experience

Titus 3.5

He saved us, by **the washing of regeneration** and **renewing of the Holy Ghost**

Baptism in water for **REMISSION** of Sins. This is the rebirth of the Old Man into the New Man.

Born Again Experience
Spoken by Jesus

Both are
Required

The phrase "Born Again" by Jesus

John 3:5

Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be **born of water and of the Spirit** he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

John 3:3

Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be **born again** he cannot see the kingdom of God.



There is Penalty for willful sin

BEFORE

He saved us, by **the washing of regeneration** and **renewing of the Holy Ghost**

No Penalty for Sin it was Paid for by Jesus; Free gift of Salvation

AFTER

And David said unto Nathan, I have sinned against the LORD. And Nathan said unto David, The LORD also hath put away thy sin; thou shalt not die.

Penalty for willful sin. No more sacrificial covering

Hebrews 10.25

For **if we sin willfully after** that we have received the **knowledge** of the truth, there remaineth **no more sacrifice for sins** seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame.

James 4:17


The man who has knowledge to do good and does not do it, to him it is sin.

There is no more atonement of for willful sin but judgment because that's mockery of God's sacrifice of His Son (Hebrews 6.6)

1Corinthians 11:27

Wherefore whosoever shall **eat**
this bread, and drink this cup
of the Lord unworthily, shall
be guilty of the body and blood
of the Lord.

There is penalty for sin
AFTER receiving knowledge



1Corinthians 11:29 - 30

For he that eateth and drinketh
unworthily, **eateth and drinketh**
damnation to himself not
discerning the Lord's body. For
this cause many are weak and
sickly among you, and many
sleep

Despising God's Grace

Hebrews 10:29

Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and

hath done despite unto the

Spirit of grace

2 Samuel 12.10

Now therefore the sword shall never depart from thine house; because **thou hast despised** **me** and hast taken the wife of Uriah the Hittite to be thy wife

Despising God's Grace

2Sa 12:9

Wherefore hast **thou despised**
the commandment of the LORD
to do evil in his sight? **thou**
hast killed Uriah the Hittite
with the sword, and hast taken
his wife to be thy wife, and
hast slain him with the sword
of the children of Ammon.

David's sinned knowingly

2Samuel 11:3

David sent and inquired about the woman. One said, **Is not this Bathsheba** the daughter of Eliam and the **wife of Uriah** the Hittite?

2Samuel 11:4 4

And David sent messengers and took her. And **she came in to him, and he lay with her** then she returned to her house.

The Judgments pronounced against David

2Sa 12:10

Now therefore the sword shall never depart from thine house; because **thou hast despised me** and hast taken the wife of Uriah the Hittite to be thy wife.

2Sa 12:11

Thus saith the LORD, Behold, **I will raise up evil against thee out of thine own house** and I will take thy wives before thine eyes, and give them unto thy neighbour, and he shall lie with thy wives in the sight of this sun.

Psalms 51:14

Deliver me from
bloodguiltiness

David desired this renewal but

God's Grace

The Lord kills the child born of the adulteress relationship

He lost his throne and had to flee

There was rape and incest in his house with Tamar

His son Absalom took his concubines and lay with them

His brother Joab murders his son Absalom

His brother sheds blood of war in peace time

2Peter 2:20

For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are **again entangled** **Therein and overcome** the latter end is worse with them than the beginning.

2Peter 2:21

For it had been better for them **not to have known the way of righteousness** than, after they have known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them.
