

The Inscription prophecy

About 20 years ago I ran across an Inscription
Prophecy from Chuck Missler.

An inscription Prophecy as I understand it is where there is dual meaning with words used in Scripture.

- There is a plain meaning of the surface text
- And there is another meaning hidden beneath the text

Basically, the late Mr. Missler opined that the Gospel of Jesus Christ was hidden within the Names of the descendants of Adam.

Here is Missler's Inscription of Names and definitions

Hebrew

Adam

Seth

Enosh

Kenan

Mahalalel

Jared

Enoch

Methuselah

Lamech

Noah

English

Man

Appointed

Mortal

Sorrow;

The Blessed God

Shall come down

Teaching

His death shall bring

The Despairing

Rest, or comfort.

The Missler interpretation looks as follows:

- **Man (is) appointed mortal sorrow; (but) the Blessed God shall come down teaching (that) His death shall bring (the) despairing rest.**

I wanted at that time to verify and check every definition but was unable until now.

- Recently I acquired an 1881 edition of Proper Names with their Original meanings or significance in the original language.

And so here are my findings of verification and how the Names were defined in the 1872 - 1882 edition.

- Note that I could only verify three Names that correspond to Missler's findings

Hebrew	English
Adam	Earthly Man
Seth	<i>Puts</i>
Enos	<i>Mortal Man in Despair</i>
Cainan	<i>Purchaser</i>
Mahalaleel	<i>He that Praises God</i>
Jared	<i>He that descends</i>
Enoch	<i>Dedicated</i>
Methuselah	<i>He has sent his death</i>
Lamech	<i>Poor</i>
Noah	<i>Rest</i>

So based upon my findings of verification I have chosen to understand the Inscription prophecy as follows:

A man of the earth **puts** **mortal man in despair.**
Adam *Seth* *Enos*

However, a purchaser **who Praises God**
Cainan *Mahalaleel*

descends **and is dedicated** **being sent unto death.**
Jared *Enoch* *Methuselah*

He brought the **poor** **rest and consolation**
Lamech *Noah*

A man of the earth puts mortal man in despair.

However, a purchaser who Praises God descends
and is dedicated unto death.

He brought the poor rest and consolation.

closing
