

Something Jesus  
talked about

---

Parable of the  
Sower

Jesus went out and sat by the sea. And great multitudes were gathered together to Him, so that He got into a boat and sat; and the whole multitude stood on the shore.

**Matthew Chapter 13**

Then He spoke many things to them in parables, saying:  
"Behold, a sower went out to sow.

And as he sowed,  
some *seed* fell by  
the wayside; and the  
birds came and  
devoured them.

Some fell on stony  
places, where they  
did not have much  
earth;

That immediately  
sprang up. Since  
there was no depth  
of earth the sun  
came up and  
scorched them

Moreover because  
they had no root  
they withered  
away

And then some of  
the seed some fell  
among thorns, and  
the thorns sprang  
up and choked  
them



Finally, other seed  
fell on good ground  
and yielded a crop:  
some a hundredfold,  
some sixty, some  
thirty.

He who has ears to  
hear, let him hear!

What does this  
mean?

The *Sower* sows  
the "Word"

The *Seed* is the  
Word of God

Its what happens

they hear?



the devil comes  
and takes away  
the word out of  
their hearts

So they will not  
believe  
and be saved

Likewise are the  
ones sown on  
stony ground  
who, when they  
hear the word

immediately receive  
it with gladness; and  
they have no root in  
themselves,  
and so endure only  
for a time

Mark 4:15-17

These are the ones  
who have no real  
commitment to  
Christ

The ones among  
the thorns are  
those that cannot  
endure difficult  
times in life

when trouble comes  
or difficulty arises to  
test the Word that  
was received

immediately they  
stumble

Mark 4:15-17

cares of this world  
and also the  
deceitfulness of  
riches choke the  
word, and he  
becomes unfruitful.

Mathew 13
