Baptism in water for remission
of Sins. This is the rebirth of
the Old Man into the New Man

Born Again Experience
Spoken by Jesus

The New Man AFTER Genuine Repentance and Baptism

2Corinthians 5:17

Therefore if any man be in Christ, **he is a new creature** old things are passed away; behold, **all things are become** **new**

2Corinthians 5:21

that we might be made the **righteousness of God** in him

Baptized into his death and raised in the newness of life

Romans 6:3-4

Know ye not, that so many of us as were **baptized into Jesus Christ** were **baptized into his death**

Romans 6.4

Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also **should walk in newness of life**

Will Baptism save you?

1 Peter 3.21

And **baptism does** now also
save you from fear by providing
you with a **clear conscience**
before God

Mark 16.16

He that believeth and is
baptized shall be saved

The phrase "Born Again" by Jesus

John 3:5

Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be **born of water and of the Spirit** he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

John 3:3

Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be **born again** he cannot see the kingdom of God.



Two things about the Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Acts 5.32

For God gives the Holy Ghost,
to THEM THAT OBEY HIM.

Romans 8.9

If you have not the Spirit of
God you are NONE OF HIS.

The Baptism in the Holy
Spirit is REQUIRED. This
is NOT an OPTION for
Salvation

Jesus set the Pattern for Baptism

Matthew 3.13-14

Then cometh Jesus from Galilee to Jordan unto John, **to** **be baptized** of him But John forbad him, saying, I have need to be baptized of thee, and comest thou to me?

Matthew 3.15

And Jesus answering said unto him, **Suffer it to be so** now: for thus it becometh us **to fulfil all** **righteousness** Then he suffered him.

Disciples were Re-Baptized into Jesus

Acts 19:1

And it came to pass, that, while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul having passed through the upper coasts came to Ephesus: and **finding certain disciples**

Act 19:2

He said unto them, **Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed?** And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost.

Disciples were re-baptized in Jesus Name

Acts 19:4

Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the **baptism of repentance** saying unto the people, that **they should believe on him which should come after him**, that is, on Christ Jesus.

Acts 19:5

When they heard this, they were **baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus**

Insufficient repentance but yet believing and baptism

A person cannot be Born Again only Believing on Jesus

Acts 8:13

Then Simon himself **believed** also: and when he was **baptized** he continued with Philip, and wondered, beholding the miracles and signs which were done.

Acts 8.21

Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.

So Simon the believer is no Christian at all; yet he believed and was baptized

How did the disciples preach Jesus

Preaching Jesus included Preaching Baptism

Acts 8:12

But when they **believed** Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were **baptized** both men and women.

Acts 8:35

Then Philip opened his mouth, and **preached unto him Jesus**
They came unto a certain water: and the eunuch said,
See, here is water; what doth hinder me to be baptized?

Preaching Jesus included Preaching Baptism

Acts 16:32

And they spake unto him the word of the Lord, and to all that were in his house.

They Preached Jesus

Acts 16.33

And he took them the same hour of the night, and washed their stripes; and was **baptized** **he and all his house**

Peter Preached Jesus in this manner

Acts 2:38

Then Peter said unto them,
Repent and be **baptized** every
one of you in the name of
Jesus Christ for the **remission**
of sins and ye shall receive
the gift of the Holy Ghost

Acts 5:32

For God gives the Holy Ghost,
to them that obey him.

Looking at evidence

Preaching Jesus included Preaching Baptism

Acts 8:12

But when they **believed** Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were **baptized** both men and women.

Acts 8:16

For as yet **The Holy Spirit was fallen upon none of them** only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.

How did they know this?

A person has manifest EVIDENCE bring Born Again

Act 10:45

And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost.

How did they know this?

A Person has manifest EVIDENCE bring Born Again

Acts 10.46

For they heard them speak with
tongues, and magnify God.

Then answered Peter,

Acts 10.47

Can any man forbid water, that
these should not be baptized
which have received the Holy
Ghost as well as we?
