appeared to many people




lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

first resurrection


First in rank of influence, and honor

likeness of his resurrection



Matthew 22.30

For in the resurrection they
neither marry, nor are given in
marriage, but are as the angels
of God in heaven

Mark 12.25

When they shall rise from the
dead they neither marry, nor
are given in marriage; but are
as the angels which are in
heaven

Resurrection at Last day

John 5.29

All that are in the graves shall hear his voice and shall come forth they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

Dan 12:2

And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.

Dan 7:9

I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and **the Ancient of days did sit** whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire.

2Co 5:10


