And **I saw a woman** sitting

on a scarlet beast, filled with names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns.

Revelation 17.5

On her forehead was a **name** having been written:

Mystery, Babylon

Biblical euphemisms of a woman

- A Woman, sitting upon scarlet beast and also sitting upon waters
- Named Mystery Babylon
- She is a Great harlot
- Commits fornication (against God)
- Has seven heads and ten horns

Revelations 17.18

And the woman whom you saw is the great city

having a kingdom over the kings of the earth.

- The great whore that sitteth upon many waters which are peoples, multitudes, nations and tongues

- ❑ She is a Great harlot
- ❑ Commits fornication (against God)
- ❑ The great city having a Kingdom which reigns over Kings

- ❑ Mystery Babylon, Mother of harlots
- ❑ Commits fornication against God
- ❑ The great city; a kingdom which reigns over Kings

Mystery Babylon represents peoples, multitudes, nations and tongues of an apostate people

Description of- Mystery Babylon

Revelation 18.3

The kings of the earth have committed fornication with her; and the merchants of the earth became rich from the power of her luxury.

Revelation 18.7

She glorified herself with luxuries saying in her heart, I sit as a queen, and I am not a widow; and I do not see mourning at all.

Imagery describing the demise of an Apostate Nation

Revelation 18.9

And the kings of the earth will weep for her, and will wail over her, those having fornicated and having luxuriated with her, when they see the smoke of her burning

Revelation 18.11

And the merchants of the earth weep and mourn over her, because no one buys their cargo any more

Cargo of gold, and silver,
and of precious stone,
and of pearls, and of fine
linen, and of purple, and
of silk, and of scarlet,

and all thyine wood, and every ivory vessel, and every vessel of very precious wood, and of bronze, and of iron, and of marble,

The Dragon Beast

Dragon - Revelations 12

And another sign was seen in the heavens. And, behold, a great red dragon having

seven heads and ten horns

And on his heads were

seven diadems.

Beast - Revelations 13

And I stood on the sand of the sea. And I saw a beast coming up out of the sea, having

seven heads and ten horns

and on his horns ten diadems

and on its heads names of blasphemy.

Daniel 7.20

Ten Horns - Seven Diadems

And of the ten horns that were in his head, and of the other which came up, and before whom three fell

$$(10 + 1) = 11 - 3 = 8$$

Revelations 17.12

Ten Horns Ten Diadems

And the ten horns you saw are ten kings who have not yet received a kingdom, but will receive authority as kings one hour with the beast.

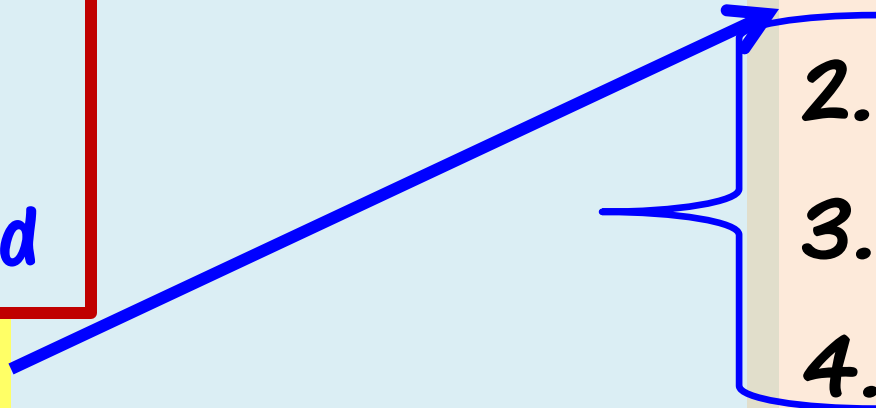
1. Lion

Connecting Ten Horns Seven Diadems to Revelation 13

Revelations 13 talks about these significant things

- ❑ Re-emergence of the ancient empire system under the fourth Kingdom of the latter days - beast from the sea
- ❑ A man that emerges on the scene beast from the earth

Ten Horns Connected to the Antichrist Revelation 17

Daniel 7.20

And of the **TEN HORNS** that were in his head, **AND OF THE OTHER WHICH CAME UP** and before whom **THREE FELL** even of that horn that had eyes, **A MOUTH THAT SPAKE VERY GREAT THINGS** whose look was more stout than his fellows.

$$(10 + 1) = 11 - 3 = 8$$
