- **Those with a perverse heart are an abomination to the LORD**

Proverbs 3.33

Even the sacrifices of the wicked are an abomination to God

- **A wicked man is loathsome to God**

Proverbs 21.27

The way of the wicked is like darkness;

- They do not know what makes them stumble.

Proverbs 4.19

He who perverts his way will become exposed

- His own iniquity shall take him over***

Proverbs 10

The fear of the wicked will come upon them; The wicked will be caught in the own lust

Proverbs 10

The perversion of the wicked will destroy them

Proverbs 11

The wicked will fall by their own wickedness

Proverbs 11

The wicked pursue evil and thus, their own death

Proverbs 11

Destruction will come to the wicked

- **God preserveth not the life of the wicked**

The calamity of the wicked man shall come suddenly

When the wicked man dies his expectation will perish

- **The light of the wicked shall be put out**

The wicked man does deceptive work

The LORD hates a proud look and a lying tongue. Thus trouble will come to the wicked.

If sinners entice you do not consent

The treasures of the wicked profit nothing

Proverbs 10

Wealth gained by dishonesty will be diminished

Proverbs 12

Beware of the sinners and do not walk in their path for everyone who traffics in ill-gotten gains do not realize that it takes away the life of its owners.

The wealth of the sinner is stored up for the righteous

The evil man trusts in his riches but he will fall

Proverbs 14

➤ ***But when he had spent all, there arose a severe famine in that land, and he began to be in want. Then he went and joined himself to a citizen of that country, and he sent him into his fields to feed swine.***

And he would gladly have filled his stomach with the pods that the swine ate, and no one gave him anything.

➤ “But when he came to himself, he said, ‘How many of my father’s hired servants have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger!’

- I will arise and go to my father, and will say to him,
“Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you,
and I am no longer worthy to be called your son. Make
me like one of your hired servants.” ’

- “And he arose and came to his father. But when he was still a great way off, his father saw him and had compassion, and ran and fell on his neck and kissed him.

- **And the son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and in your sight, and am no longer worthy to be called your son.'**

- **“But the father said to his servants, ‘Bring out the best robe and put it on him, and put a ring on his hand and sandals on his feet.**

➤ **And bring the fattened calf here and kill it, and let us eat and be merry; for this my son was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.’ And they began to be merry.**

The humble man shall find new Joy in the Lord and the poorest shall exalt in the God of his salvation!

➤ He who has erred shall arrive at understanding!

If you are one of those with only a very weak commitment to God, then do as the Prophet said to do:

➤ **Seek the LORD while He may be found,
Call upon Him while He is near.**

➤ **Let the wicked forsake his way,
And the unrighteous man his thoughts;
Let him return to the LORD,**

➤ *And God will have mercy on him...*

For with the Lord there is Mercy and with Him there is redemption.
